The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Henry Ridgely, John Davidson and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Harwood Esquire the sum of twenty five pounds current Money for one quarters salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates due the first day of last month.

The board received a letter from Dehar Thompson Esquire Sheriff of Caroline County dated the twenty second day of March last stating that he had in pursuance of the Instructions received from the Executive on the eighth day of April seventeen hundred and Ninety five, delivered on the dividing line between this State and the State of Delaware a certain Thomas Smith to Seth Griffith the agent appointed by the Governor of the State of Delaware and that William Andrews had escaped.
