By the Petition of Nathan Hughes of Harford County it appears that at March Term seventeen hundred and Ninety five of the Court of the said County he entered into a Recognizance in open Court for his appearance to answer an assault and Battery committed by him upon Aquila Lord. That he appeared agreeably to the tenor of the said Recognizance submitted and was fined but that his appearance submission and fine were not recorded by means whereof his said Recognizance was forfeited and a Capias ad satisfaciendum issued thereupon to March Term seventeen hundred and Ninety six he therefore prays a remission of the said Forfeiture. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from a Recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that the said Nathan Hughes be released from the aforesaid forfeiture.

George Young of Harford County by his Petition sets forth that at March Term last of the said County he was fined the usual sum for keeping ordinary without licence. The Petitioner represents that at August Term seventeen hundred and Ninety four he applied to Harford County Court for licence to keep an ordinary which was granted to him but that his name was omitted by the Clerk to be entered on the list of ordinary Keepers. That he paid the sum required by the act of assembly for said licence to the Clerk. That his name not appearing on the list of licenced ordinary Keepers the Grand Jury found a presentment against him at March Term seventeen hundred and Ninety six and being by law precluded from contradicting the record by parol evidence he was fined as one who kept ordinary without licence; he therefore prays to be released from the aforesaid fine and a remission of the said Fine being recommended to the Board by the Court of the said County. It is ordered that the Fine aforesaid be and the same is hereby remitted on payment of costs of suit.
