Thursday August the 4. 1796

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Harwood Esquire, the sum of twenty five pounds current Money for one quarters salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates due the first instant.

Friday August the 5. 1796

The Council met. Present The Honble James Brice, William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Benjamin Prumsey Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds current Money for one quarters salary as Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals due the first instant.
