Friday August the 19. 1796

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidfon, William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas White armourer at Frederick Town the sum of Eighty six pounds eighteen shillings and nine pence current Money as per account passed the auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Robert Isabell the sum of three pounds twelve shillings current Money for going as Express to Baltimore.

The board proceeded to the appointment of a Register of Wills for Charles County in the Room of John Munkets deceased when Humphrey Barnes was appointed, ordered that Commission issue to him; Commission issued accordingly.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^{rs} Ann
