

Monday October 24. 1796

The Council met. Present. The Honble James Brice, Henry Ridgely John Davidson, William Kelly and James Thomas.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of a Surveyor of Queen Anns County in the room of Robert Seney deceased, and upon examination of the Ballots it appeared that Zacharias Roberts had a Majority of votes whereupon he is declared to be duly elected Surveyor of Queen Anns County. Tuesday November 1. 1796

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governour and The Honble James Brice, Henry Ridgely and John Davidson.

Ordered, that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Jeremiah Townley Chase Esquire, five hundred pounds for one years Salary as Judge of the General Court due first of May last.

Wednesday November 2. 1796

The Council met. Present as on Yesterday

Ordered by the Governour, that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mr Ann Lebacker, the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay, due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governour, that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mr Thomas Walley the sum of fifty pounds for six months allowance due him the twenty fourth of September last.

Ordered, that the said Treasurers pay to Henry Ridgely Esquire, thirty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarters Salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurers pay to James Brice, Esquire, thirty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarters Salary as a member of the Council; due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurers pay to Mr. Jull Fowler, eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters Salary as messengers of the Council; due as above.
