Given in Council at the City of Annapolis under the Seal of the State of Maryland, the twenty sixth day of November, in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the western Shore pay to Ensign Jeru Bowen, the Sum of thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for nine months half pay, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurers pay to James Thomas Esquire, the Sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarters Salary as a member of the Council, due as above.

Tuesday November 29. 1796

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the members.

John Roberts Esquire was appointed one of the Associate Justices of Talbot County Court, and Commission issued to Howes Goldsborough and John Roberts as Associate Justices of the said County.

Ordered, that the Treasurers of the western Shore pay to pay to the Legal Representative of Henry Warfield late Clerk of the Senate deceased, the Sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings for three quarters Salary, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurers pay to Mr. John Culbert eight pounds fifteen shillings for riding as Express to the Sheriff of Harford County as per account passed by the Auditor.
