

Saturday February 11. 1797

The Honble William Pitt and John Johnson appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Robert Denny, fifty two pounds ten shillings, for three months salary as Auditor General; due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant Henry G. Baker, the sum of fifteen pounds, for three months half pay, due as above.

Monday February 13. 1797

The Council met. Present The Honble William Pitt, John Davidson and John Johnson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Rumsey fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals; due the first instant.

Tuesday February 14. 1797

The Council met. Present as on yesterday.

Ordered, that the Testamentary System reported by the Chancellor in pursuance of the request of the Legislature be printed for consideration with the acts of Assembly of the last Session. agreeably to a Report of a Committee on that subject. be inserted after the list of laws.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of Inspectors for Somerset County and appointed:

For the warehouse at Princess Anne Zadock Long

For the warehouse at Madduxs Island James Waters

For the warehouse at Coulbourns Creek John Smith of Horsey

For the warehouse at Bohoboth Benjamin Schoolfield

William Stewart was appointed Inspector at Green Hill warehouse in Somerset County.

Wednesday February 15. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Pitt, John Davidson and John Johnson

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson three pounds fifteen shillings for three months pension due the first instant.
