fines.

for printing done for the State as per account passed.

Friday March the 24. 1797

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the western Shore  
pay to Captain Perry Benson, the sum of nearly seven pounds ten  
shillings for one quarters half pay due first day of last month.

Friday March the 31. 1797

His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Hilly  
appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the western Shore pay  
to Captain Richard Anderson forty five pounds for six months  
half pay due the first day of last month.

Saturday April the 1. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The  
Honble William Hilly John Davidson and John Johnson.
