Saturday April the 22. 1797

The Council met Present The Honble William Hilly, James Thomas and John Davidson.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Frederick Green Printer to the State the sum of unity two pounds twelve shillings and one penny half penny for printing same as per account papered by the auditor.

Monday May the 1. 1797

The Council met Present The Honble John Davidson, James Price and John Johnson.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Price, Esq. the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a member of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gabriel Duvall, Esquire one hundred and forty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters salary as Judge of the General Court due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Nonian Penning the sum of one hundred and twenty five pounds for six months salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Dosey twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to James Thomas Esq. fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a member of the Council, due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Jones the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Archibald Van Horn, Esquire, the sum of twelve pounds ten shillings for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Senate due as above.
