

Edward Coursey was appointed an associate Justice for Queen Anns County in the room of James Hendman, Esquire, resigned, and Commission issued accordingly to Edward Harris and Edward Coursey as associate Justices of Queen Anns County.

By the Petition of John Key of Baltimore it appears that in the year seventeen hundred and ninety five he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of ten pounds before the Justices of Baltimore County Criminal Court for the appearance of a certain Matthew Davis to answer a charge of having violated the peace. That in consequence of the non appearance of the said Davis the said Recognizance was declared to be forfeited. The Petitioner represents that he is very poor and has a wife and several young children dependant on him for support and that if the above sum is exacted he must inevitably go to goal. The Petitioner further states that since the forfeiture of the said Recognizance the said Matthew Davis has been taken and is now in the possession of the Sheriff of the said County to answer the charge aforesaid. He therefore prays a Remission of the said forfeiture. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the Recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that he be released from the said forfeiture.
