

Thursday May the 11. 1797

His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Thomas appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Marshall Esquire, the sum of one hundred pounds for six months salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals, due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Joseph Dawson, the sum of three pounds fifteen shillings for three months pension, due the first instant.

Friday May the 12. 1797

The Council met. Present The Honble William Kelly, James Thomas John Davidson and John Johnson.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ensign Jeru Bowen the sum of eleven pounds five shillings for three months half pay due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant John Lynn fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay, due as above.

Saturday May 13. 1797

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Kelly James Thomas John Davidson James Price and John Johnson.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Abraham Gambell, late of the Maryland line two pounds five shillings for three months allowance, due him the first day of February last.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of one hundred and eight pounds eighteen shillings and four pence, for work done at the armoury, as per account passed by the auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of thirty one pounds five shillings for one quarters salary as armourer at Frederick Town, due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Colonel Mack Forest the sum of thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Allen Luger Esquire the sum of thirty one pounds seventeen shillings and six pence as per account passed.
