

Friday June the 16. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Hilly James Thomas John Davidson and John Johnson.

It being represented to the Board that a quantity of Public Arms Tents and accoutrements which were drawn out of the Armory at Frederick Town for the late western Expedition are still in the hands of the Militia or of other persons unauthorised to keep them. Those persons who are in possession of such Arms Tents and accoutrements are hereby directed to return them and in order to procure a compliance with the above direction Colonel John Lynn is appointed in Allegany County and Mr. Allen Lynn in Washington and Frederick Counties to receive those articles and to forward them to the Armory.

The following order was drawn on General Mountjoy Bayley of Frederick Town.

Please to pay to Mr. Allen Lynn or his order the sum of seventy five pounds out of the Money remaining in your hands from the sum sent to you for the Repairs of the Magazine at Frederick Town.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of a Register of Wills of Alberty County in the room of Francis King deceased, where Joseph Wilkinson was appointed. Ordered, that Commission issue to him. Commission issued accordingly.

Monday June the 19. 1797

The Council met. Present The Honble William Hilly James Thomas, John Davidson and John Johnson.

Levin Gale was appointed one of the Judges of the Orphans Court for Somerset County in the room of John Williams deceased, and Commission issued accordingly to William Jones, Monahan, Lambert Hyland and Levin Gale as Justices of the Orphans Court of the said County.

Henry Ridgely was appointed an associate Justice of Ann Arundel County in the room of Nicholas Farroll Coquin resigned and Commission issued accordingly to Samuel Ridout and Henry Ridgely as associate Justices of the said County.
