Friday August the 4. 1797

The Council met. Present The Honble William Hilly, James Thomas and John Johnson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gabriel Duvall, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and forty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters salary as Judge of the General Court due the first instant.

Saturday August the 5. 1797

The Council met. Present as on yesterday.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Johnson Esquire, the sum of one hundred pounds for half years salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant Henry J. Baker, the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Monday August the 7. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and The Honble William Hilly, James Thomas and John Davidson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John H. Stone, forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence, for one quarters half pay, due the first instant.

Thursday August the 10. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Hilly, James Thomas and John Davidson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lazarus Harmon, the sum of eleven pounds five shillings for nine months pension due the first instant.

Friday August the 11. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and The Honble William Hilly, James Thomas and John Davidson.

The Board proceeded to the consideration of the letter of the first instant from the Secretary at War enclosing an act of Congress authorizing a Detachment from the militia of the United States, and on examining the General Return of the militia of this State, determined on the quota to be furnished by each Division as follows
