Thursday August the 31. 1797

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Hon. William Kelly, James Thomas and James Beir.

By the Petition of Morris Fitzgerald of Baltimore County accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings of the Court of the said County from which it appears that at August Term seven hundred and ninety seven the said Fitzgerald was presented for retailing Spirituous liquors without licence and fined by the Court the quantity of six hundred pounds of Tobacco and the sum of one pound ten shillings. The Petitioner states that he is poor. He prays a Remission of the said fine. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the same.
