

The summonses which I issued to George Calvert, Thomas G. Addison, Truman Tyler, Peter Wood, Thomas F. Brooke, Francis Piny, Levin C. Wailer and George A. Leiper to testify as above were returned summoned.

The Council for the Parties being engaged in the General Court the hearing of the Petition of Joseph Boone was adjourned till to Morrow nine of Clock.

Wednesday November the 1. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Members.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Amian Cunnicy, the sum of one hundred and twenty five pounds, for six months Salary as Clerk of the Council, due this day.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Gabriel Duval, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and forty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters Salary as Judge of the General Court due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to William Hilly Esquire the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters Salary as a member of the Council due as above.

Ordered, by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Anne Leach the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Truman, fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

The Board proceeded to the hearing of the Petition of Joseph Boone, and the Evidence adduced on his part, and adjourned till to Morrow Morning nine of Clock.

Thursday November the 2. 1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Members.

Summons issued at the request of Stottly Maddox to James Staylor.

The Board went on with the hearing of the Petition of Joseph Boone.

Clement Hill, Francis Hall, and Isaac Nesmith, proved four days attendance each, Jesse Greenwell, James Meebeen, Simeon Darnall, John Waring Junior and Francis Hamilton proved three days attendance, William Ornal, John Darnall, Robert Bowie proved four days attendance. Samuel M. Peterson proved five days attendance as witnesses on the part of Joseph Boone.

Samuel Hepburn proved three days attendance as a witness on the part of the Plaintiff.

The Council adjourned until to Morrow Morning nine of Clock.

Friday November the 3. 1797

The Council met. Present The Honble William Hilly, James Thomas, John Davidge, James Brice and John Johnson.

The Board went on with the Petition of Joseph Boone.
