Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lazarus Harmon, the sum of three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters pension, due the first day of November last.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Dawson, the sum of three pounds fifteen shillings for three Months pension, due as above.

Friday December 15-1797

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan O. Wilmer, Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Wilmer, the sum of nine pounds fifteen shillings for Riding Expes by order of the Governor and Council to the Sheriff of Kent County: as per account paid by the Auditor General.

Monday December the 18-1797

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Pease the sum of four pounds eleven shillings and four pence half penny for riding Expes to General James Lloyd as per account paid.
