one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Dury, the sum of one hundred and
thirty seven pounds ten Shillings current Money, for one quarters salary as Auditor General; due
as above.

sum of eight pounds four shillings, for painting done by them for the State as per
