Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Arthur Shaaff, Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council; due the first instant.

Friday February the 16. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidjon, James Thomas, Jonathan O. Wilmer, Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson.

John Muir was appointed Notary Public for Anne Arundel County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Benjamin Brooks was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Upper Marlborough Warehouse in Prince Georges County, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Thursday February the 22. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble James Thomas, Jonathan O. Wilmer, and Arthur Shaaff.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Thomas, Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council; due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Archibald Van Horn, Esquire, the sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence, for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Senate; due the first instant.

Friday February the 23. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble James Thomas, Jonathan O. Wilmer, Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Johnson, Esquire, the sum of one hundred pounds, for six Months salary as a Member of the Council; due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Jones, Esquire, the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals; due as above.
