Monday February the 26. 1798

Saturday March the 3. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, Jonathan P. Wilmer, Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson

Daniel Reintzel was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court of Montgomery County in the room of Thomas Turner resigned, and Commission issued accordingly to Thomas Campkin, Richard Wootton and Daniel Reintzel as Judges of the Court of the said County.

Monday March the 5. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and Arthur Shaaff.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Comwell the sum of sixty seven pounds ten Shillings, for nine Months half pay due the first day of last Month.

Tuesday March the 6. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and Arthur Shaaff.

By the Petition of Benjamin Taylor and Richard Taylor of Montgomery County accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings from the Court of the said County, it appears that they entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty five pounds before Lawrence Ornel a Justice of the Peace for Montgomery County for the appearance of a certain Hugh Ornel at the next ensuing Court. The Record states that the said Hugh Ornel did appear but through ignorance he did not apply to the Court for a legal discharge, but left it after some days attendance, and withdrew the Petitioners knew not that in consequence of which the said Recognizance was declared to be forfeited. The Petitioners state that they are extremely poor and unable to pay. They therefore pray to be heard from the said Recognizance. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the same.
