

Wednesday March the 7. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and Arthur Shaff.
Thomas Jennings was appointed Notary Public for Baltimore County, and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ignatius Davis was appointed Justice for Frederick County, and commission issued to him.

Thursday March the 8. 1798

The Honble James Thomas and Jonathan P. Wilmer appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Green, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and thirty one pounds, five shillings, for one quarter's salary as Painter to the State, due the first day of February last.

Friday March the 13. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and John Johnson.

Henry Hale was appointed an Associate Justice for Saint Marys County in the room of George Platier resigned, and commission issued accordingly to Barton Tabbs and Henry Hale as Associate Justices of Saint Marys County.

John Thomas was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Talbot County, and a commission issued to the said County including him.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Green, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and twenty four pounds for one quarter's salary as Painter to the State, due the first day of November last.

Saturday March the 16. 1798

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and John Johnson.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to His Excellency the Governor, the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars, for the purpose of repairing and furnishing the Government House by virtue of a Resolution of the last Session.

Sunday March the 23. 1798

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan P. Wilmer.

Ordered, That the Painter to the State be directed to print six thousand Marriage Licences agreeably to an act of Assembly passed at the last Session, and that he deliver them with all convenient speed to the Clerk of the Council.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Dawson, the sum of three pounds, fifteen shillings for three months half pay, due the first day of February last.

Monday April the 8. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and John Johnson.
