The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer, Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Anderson, the sum of twenty two pounds ten Shillings current Money, for one quarters half pay, due the first day of February last.

Saturday April the 28. 1798

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan P. Wilmer and Arthur Shaaff.

By the Petition of John Miller of Baltimore County accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears that he entered into two Recognizances in the sum of twenty pounds each the one for the appearance of a certain Negro Ball at August Term from ten hundred and Ninety four, the other for the appearance of a certain Andrew Day at November Term last which were by the said Court declared to be forfeited. The Petitioner states that he is poor and has a large family to support. The Board on consideration of which and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do advise and direct that he be released from the said Recognizances.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Mark Fouist, the sum of thirty three pounds fifteen Shillings current Money, for one quarters half pay, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Minian Pinkney, the sum of sixty five pounds twelve Shillings and six pence current Money, for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Gabriel Duvall, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten Shillings current Money for one quarters salary as Judge of the General Court, due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Gunn, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and thirty one pounds five Shillings current Money, for one quarters salary as Printer to the Council, due as above.
