By the Petition of Alexander Baillia of Allegany County accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined on two several presentments at April Term last the sum of six pounds Current Money each for retailing Spirituous liquors contrary to law.

The Petitioner states that he had taken out a licence from the collector of the Revenue as a retail dealer of Wine and that he did not think it necessary to take out another under the State Government. He therefore prays to be released from the said fines. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that the said Alexander Baillia be released from the above fines.
