Tuesday July the 10.

The Council met. Present The honorable James Thomas, Jonathan B. Williams and John Johnson. Commission issued to John Thomas as Sheriff of Talbot County in the room of Edward Cox deceased.

Thursday July the 12. 1798

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council. Ordered, that the Armour at Easton, deliver to the order of Nicholas Hammond, Esquire, any number of Arms and accoutrements he may demand, not exceeding one hundred and twenty.

Friday July the 13. 1798

The Council met. Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Winter, Printer at Frederick Town the Sum of Thirteen pounds Thirteen Shillings and nine pence, for printing done for the State, as per Accounts passed by the Auditor.

Saturday July the 14. 1798

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

Applications were made by Colonel Plumm for three hundred Stand of Arms, and Captain Joseph H. Nicholson for fifty, postponed to Monday.

Whereas Theodore Hodgkin was appointed on the eighteenth of June 1794 a Captain of the 31st Regiment, and was commissioned by the Name of Alexander instead of Theodore. Ordered that a Commission giving equal Rank issue to him correcting the Mistake.

Monday July the 16. 1798

The Council met. Present as on Saturday.

Tuesday July the 17. 1798

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable John Davidson, James Thomas, Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson.

Ordered, that the Armour at Frederick Town forward to Baltimore by the first private opportunity to the care of Colonel John Stricker ten Barrels of Powder out of the Magazine in that place.
