The Council agreed to reconsider their determination respecting the delivery of arms to the Militia of Baltimore Town when it was ordered that Colonel Flemm shall have an order on the Armour at Frederick Town for three hundred Stand. Colonel John Stricker for one hundred, and Captain John Chalmers for twenty two Stand. and that Bonds be given to the State conditioned for the return of the said Arms when called for by the Executive. Therefore ordered, that the Armour at Frederick Town deliver to the orders of General Samuel Smith four hundred and seventy two Stand of Arms complete.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Jones Esquire, the sum of seven eight pounds two Shillings and six pence for one quarters Salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Colonel Uriah Forrest thirty three pounds fifteen Shillings, for one quarters half pay, due as above.
