Monday August the 6. 1798

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant Henry G. Baker the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay the first instant.

Thursday August the 9. 1798

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan O. Wilmer

Ordered, that forty five Muskets complete three hundred Flints and fifteen pounds of Powder be transmitted to Captain William Robinson of Dorchester County.

William Driscoll was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Kent County and a New Commission issued to the said County including him.
