The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The honorable John Davidson James Thomas and Jonathan. A. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Armour at Frederick Town, deliver to the order of General James Smith, two hundred Stand of Arms complete.

Monday August the 13. 1798

The Council met. Present The honorable John Davidson, James Thomas, Jonathan. A. Wilmer Arthur Shaaff and John Johnson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White Armour at Frederick Town, the sum of Twenty seven pounds ten Shillings and seven pence for work done at the Armoury: as per Account passed.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of Thirty one pounds five Shillings, for one quarters Salary as Armour at Frederick Town; due the first instant.

Ordered by The Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain James Somerswell, the sum of twenty two pounds ten Shillings, for one quarters half pay; due as above.

Wednesday August the 15. 1798

Thursday August the 16. 1798

The Council met. Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Archibald Van Horn the sum of fourteen pounds one Shilling and three pence for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the Senate; due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Shaw, the sum of fifty pounds to be by him accounted for.

Richard Marriot was appointed and commissioned Inspector of Salt in the Indian Landing Warehouse in Anne Arundel County in the room of Sanclot Warfield resigned.
