Friday September the 7. 1798

In consequence of a Requisition from his Excellency Thomas Mifflin, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania bearing date the Third day of April last the following Warrant was issued to the Sheriffs of Montgomery and Prince Georges Counties.

The State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Montgomery County Greeting. Whereas a certain James Daugherty is charged with the crime of Horse stealing by the affidavits of Stephen McNulty and Thomas McNulty inhabitants of Pennsylvania authentic Copies of which affidavits have been transmitted to us by the Governor of Pennsylvania. and Whereas it is represented by his Excellency Thomas Mifflin Governor of the said State of Pennsylvania, that the said James Daugherty has fled from the said State from Justice and is now residing in this State
