

and the said Thomas Mifflin, Esquire, hath in pursuance of the Constitution of the United States and the Act of Congress intitled an Act respecting fugitives from Justice and persons escaping from the Service of their Masters demanded of us that the said James Daugherty be arrested and secured so that he may be delivered up to such person as may be appointed by the Executive of the said State of Pennsylvania to be removed to the said State having jurisdiction of the crime wherewith he is charged. You are therefore hereby commanded to take the body of the said James Daugherty if he shall be found in your Parish and him safe keep so that you have him ready to be delivered up to such agent as may be appointed by the Executive of the said State of Pennsylvania to be removed to the said State, there to answer the charge exhibited against him as aforesaid, and how you shall execute this Warrant you shall notify to us with all convenient dispatch. Given in Council at the City of Annapolis under the Seal of the State of Maryland this seventh day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight.

By the Petition of Robert Hollahan of Baltimore County it appears that he was presented and indicted at August Term last for assaulting a certain John Adam Clark and was fined the sum of six pounds in Money. The Petitioner states that he is now confined in Baltimore for the said fine. That he has a wife and four small children.
