

By the Petition of John Roswell, Haniel Roswell and Edward Rozwell of
Prince Georges County accompanied by a Transcript and Recommendation of the

sum of ten pounds each for their appearance at September Term 1794 to
answer presentments for assaults committed on Robert Hull and which for
their non appearance were declared to be forfeited. The Court represent
that the Presentments were never heard and that it does not appear
that Hull was appeared on behalf of the State to prosecute the said
Presentments. The Court further state that the Civil Suits against
them were nonproced at April Term 1795. They from a belief that the
Recognizances were not forfeited from a contempt of the Court do
therefore recommend a Remission of the same. The Board on consideration
of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of
the said County do order and direct that the said Recognizances be
remitted.
