

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the western Shore pay to Benjamin Rumsey Esquire, the sum of Seventy eight pounds two shillings and six pence, for one quarters salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to William Harwood, Esquire, the sum of two hundred and twelve pounds ten shillings for two years salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due as above.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant Henry C. Baker, the sum of fifteen pounds, for one quarters half pay, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to John Coates, Esquire, the sum of thirty pounds, for one years salary as Armourer at Easton, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to John Coates Esquire, the sum of four pounds seven shillings and four pence half penny, as per account paid by the Auditor.

By the Petition of Thomas Brigg of Dorchester County, it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds for the appearance of a certain William Woolford at October Term 1796 to answer an assault, and Battery committed on Thomas Jones which was declared forfeited. The Petitioner states that he submitted the case at October Term 1797 for the said Woolford and that the said Woolford was fined the sum of two Dollars. The Petitioner further states that he has duly paid the fine and hath fully secured to be paid the fees and costs of the prosecution. He prays a Remission of the said forfeiture. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that he be released from the aforesaid forfeiture.
