instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to James Thomas Esquire, fifty nine  
pounds seven shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as a member of  
the Council: due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Rumsey Esquire, the sum of seven  
eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as Judge of the  
Court of Appeals: due as above.
