Monday March the 4/1799

The Council met. Present as on Thursday.

Washington Boyd was appointed Notary Public for Prince Georges County
and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Tuesday March the 5/1799

The Council met. Present as on Yesterday.

Levinsky Rawlings was appointed Coroner for Cecil County and Commission
issued to him accordingly.

Wednesday March the 6/1799

The Council met. Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered that Mr. John Shaw repair the ceiling over the Stairs leading to the
Council Room, and that he paint the Department of the General Council
Columns and forth in the Saloon of the State House and repair the
ceiling of the same.

Ordered that Mr. Shaw employ persons to mount six pieces of ordnance
a Resolution of the General Assembly at their last session.
