Monday March the 11/1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Wreak Forest, the sum of thirty three pounds five shillings for one quarters half pay, due the first day of last Month.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilmer, twenty one pounds two shillings for riding as Express as per account passed by the Auditor.

Tuesday March the 12/1799

The Council met. Present the Honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Price, Esquire, the sum of fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due the first day of last Month.
