Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Somerville, twenty two pounds ten shillings, for one quarters half pay due the first day of February last.

Tuesday April The 2. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable James Thomas, James Price and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

A New Commission of the Peace issued to Cecil County including John Gelpin, Joshua George, Daniel Sheddine and Edward Foard who were left out of the Commission through mistake.

Wednesday April The 3. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and The honorable James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Richard H. Heath was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Cecil County, and a New Commission issued to the said County including him.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Guor, Esquire, the sum of three hundred and twenty five pounds, to be by him accounted for.

Monday April The 8. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Harwood Esquire, the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the first day of February last.
