Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Allen Luyton Esquire,  
the sum of Sixty three pounds seven shillings and six pence, as per account  
paid by the auditor.

Wednesday April the 17. 1799

The Council met. Present The honorable Arthur Shaaff, John Davidson, James Thomas  
and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

By the Petition of Charles Burnett of Prince Georges County accompanied by a  
Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he  
was presented at April Term instant for dealing with a certain Negro Will in  
property of John Powis and was fined by the said Court the quantity of one  
thousand pounds of Tobacco. The Petitioner states that he had removed from the County  
of Virginia to Prince Georges County but a few months before and that he was  
ignorant of the laws of the State. The Board on consideration of the circumstances  
and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order  
that the said Charles Burnett be released from the said fine.
