Tuesday April the 30. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and the honorable Arthur Shaffer,
Davidson, and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Frederick Geun the sum
of Ninety two pounds for printing done as per account passed by the Auditor.

Wednesday May the 1. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and the honorable Arthur Shaffer,
John Davidson, and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ninian Pinkney, the sum
of one hundred and fifty pounds, for six months salary as Clerk of the Council, due
this day.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gabriel Durall, Esquire,
the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarters
salary as Judge of the General Court, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Geun Esquire, the sum of
one hundred and thirty one pounds five shillings, for one quarters salary
as Printer to the State, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Ann Leacher, the sum of
fifteen pounds, for one quarters half pay, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Archibald Van Horn, Esquire, the sum
of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence, for one quarters salary as
Clerk of the Senate, due as above.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to
Captain Richard Dorsey twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence
for one quarters half pay due as above.

Thursday May the 2. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor, and the honorable
Shaffer John Davidson and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Van
the sum of fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence, for one
as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to James Thomas, Esquire, the sum of
fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence, for one
as a member of the Council, due as above.
