

it appears that he entered into a Recognizance at September Term 1796 in the sum of twenty pounds for the appearance of a certain William Fogleson to answer to an indictment and Battery committed on a certain Matthew Hart. The Petitioner states that said Fogleson appeared under his Recognizance for two or three times and that Hart did not appear to testify against him. That the said Fogleson afterwards went to Charleston South Carolina where he has since resided, and that the said Hart at the Term after the said Fogleson had removed to Charleston was returned summoned. and that at April Term 1797 the Recognizance was declared forfeited. He therefore prays to be released from the said forfeiture. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that the said John M. Gantt be released from the said forfeiture.
