John Addison, William Bayley and William Lyles were appointed Justices of the Peace for Prince Georges County, and a new Commission issued to the said County including them.

By the Petition of George Brown and Alexander Thompson of the City of Baltimore it appears, that they entered into a Recognizance before Job Smith for the appearance of a certain Jacob Smith in Baltimore City Court at January Term last to answer for assaulting John Stump. The Petitioners state that all prosecution against the said Jacob Smith has ceased and determined. The Court having recommended a Remission of the said Recognizance Ordered, that the said John Brown and Alexander Thompson be released from the aforesaid forfeiture.

Henry Stevenson was appointed and Commissioned Inspector of Tobacco at Fells Point Warehouse in Baltimore County.
