Saturday May the 31. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and the honorable Arthur Shaaff, John Davidson and Jonathan O. Wilmer.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Druff the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings, for one quarters salary; due the first instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Winter, the sum of twelve pounds five shillings and seven pence half penny, for printing and for the Hall; as per account passed by the auditor.

Paul Willis Proskers was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Upper Marlborough Warehouse in Prince Georges County vice William Bowie who declines accepting and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Monday June the 2. 1799

The Council met. Present the honorable Arthur Shaaff, John Davidson, and James Thomas.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Maguader Trustee for the Children of the late Reginald Hillary on account of Elizabeth Hillary eighty six pounds three shillings and one pence for half pay; due the first day of May last.

Wednesday June the 4. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Arthur Shaaff, John Davidson and James Thomas.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson, the sum of forty five pounds for six months half pay; due the first day of last month.

Monday June the 10. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Arthur Shaaff, John Davidson, James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan O. Wilmer.
