

Monday July the 22. 1799

The Council met. Present The honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan Wilmer.

George Hall Esquire was appointed a Judge of the Orphans Court for Frederick, and Samuel Gilpin and a Commission issued to Sidney George, John Mississau, George Hall as Judges of the Orphans Court for said County.

Joseph Wallace and Richard Olaham were appointed Justices of the Peace for Cecil County and Commission issued to the said County including them.

Monday July the 29. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honble John Davidson, James Bruce and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered that the armour at Frederick Town delivered to Colonel John Ross Key have two Hand of arms complete for the use of the Select Company attached to his Regiments.

Thursday August the 1. 1799

The Council met. Present The honble John Davidson, Jonathan R. Wilmer and James Bruce.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Andrew Walker, the sum of fifteen pounds, for one quarters half pay, due this day.

Friday August the 2. 1799

The Council met. Present The honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gabriel Durall Esqur the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarters Salary as Judge of the General Court, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Penhory Esqur the sum of eight pounds seven shillings and six pence as per account paid

Saturday August the 3. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honble John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Roman fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Roman eight pounds two shillings and six pence, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Court of Appeals, due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan R. Wilmer the sum of sixty nine pounds seven shillings, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council, due as above.
