

Monday July the 22. 1799

The Council met. Present The honorable John Davidson, James Thomas, and Jonathan
Wilmer.

George Gale Esquire, was appointed a Judge of the Orphans Court for fixing
with Samuel Gilpin dead and Commission issued to Sidney George, John Miffleson and
George Gale as Judges of the Orphans Court for said County.

Joseph Wallace and Richard Oldham were appointed Justices of the Peace for
said County and Commission issued to the said County including them.

Monday July the 29. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable John Davidson, James
Price and Jonathan. P. Wilmer.

Ordered that the armour at Frederick Town deliver to Colonel John Ross Key Senior
two Hand of arms complete for the use of the Militia Company attached to his Regiment.

Thursday August the 1. 1799

The Council met. Present The honorable John Davidson, Jonathan. P. Wilmer and James
Price.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Ann Le Vacher, the
sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due this day.

Friday August the 2. 1799

The Council met. Present The honorable John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan. P.
Wilmer.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gabriel Duran Esquire
the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarters
Salary as Judge of the General Court; due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Penning Esquire
the sum of eight pounds seven shillings and ten pence as per account passed

Saturday August the 3. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable John
Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan. P. Wilmer.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Thomas
fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence for one quarters Salary as
Member of the Council; due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Smith
eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters Salary as
Court of Appeals; due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan. P. Wilmer
of sixty nine pounds seven shillings for one quarters Salary as
Council; due as above.
