Security for a fine imposed on Hugh Loney to the amount of twenty pounds and
also for John Woodburn for the sum of ten pounds in the year five hundred
and ninety three. that the said Loney and Woodburn sometime
afterwards left the State by which means he has never been able to deliver them
in Court or obtain the Money. that the said Loney and Woodburn are both
dead, and that he is wholly unable to pay the said fines, being obliged from
other misfortunes to take the benefit of the Insolvent act at the last Session
The Board on consideration of the circumstances do release the said Johnson
from the said fines.
