

Tuesday September the 10. 1799

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, Jonathan P. Wilmer and James Price.

By the Petition of John Sutton of Prince Georges County it appears that he was bound over in the Year 1798 to keep the Peace with John Sintclair. That he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of thirty pounds with two Sureties in the sum of fifteen pounds each. The Petitioner states that some few days afterwards he satisfied the said Sintclair that he had no cause for swearing the peace against him, and all differences were settled between the said Sintclair and the Petitioner. The Petitioner states that he is a seafaring Man and at last April Term was on a Voyage to Baltimore. The Board on consideration of which circumstances do order and direct that they be released from the aforesaid forfeiture.

By the Petition of Nathaniel McGinnis of Harford County accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined at August Term last on two several Presentments six hundred pounds on each for selling liquors without licence.
