By the Petition of William King of Prince Georges County accompanied by a transcript  
from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears that he entered into a  
Recognizance in the sum of ten pounds for his appearance at the said Court at April  
Term 1797. The Petitioner states that he attended equally to the tenor of his Recognizance  
at the said April Term 1797 and supposed that he had complied with every thing that  
would be required of him otherwise he would have attended at the subsequent Terms. The  
Petitioner states that he is poor and has a wife children. He therefore prays a Remission  
of the said forfeiture. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from  
the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that the said  
William King be released from the aforesaid forfeiture.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Moses  
Leconte the sum of two pounds eight shillings and nine pence for  
transporting the arms from Baltimore to Easton, as per account paper.  
Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Colonel Robert Bowie, the sum of  
sixteen pounds seventeen shillings and six pence for transporting the arms  
from Frederick Town to Baltimore as per account paper by the Auditor.

Monday September the 30. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur  
Shaaff John Davidson, James Price and Jonathan P. Wilmer.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
Captain Richard Anderson the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings  
one quarters half pay due the first day of August last.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to the Virginia  
of Captain Richard Dorsy, the sum of five pounds for half pay.
