

Wednesday October The 8: 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan P. Wilmer.

Ordered that Valentini Brother Esquire deliver to Colonel John Lyon twenty two Stand of Arms complete for the use of the Milit Company attached to his Regiment.

Wednesday October The 16: 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and The Honble Arthur Stauff John Davidson, James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan P. Wilmer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs Gunat & Brown, the sum of four hundred and sixty three Dollars and twenty five cents for printing done for the State.

Ordered, that Valentini Brother Esquire deliver to Colonel Thomas P. Beall twenty two Stand of Arms complete for the use of the Milit Company attached to his Regiment.

Monday October The 21: 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

A Warrant in the usual form issued to the Sheriff of Baltimore County for the delivery of Elijah Crane Purdy a fugitive from Justice from the State of Pennsylvania.

Wednesday October The 23: 1799

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan P. Wilmer.

John H. Folius was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a New Commission issued including him.

Thursday October The 24: 1799

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Price, James Thomas and Jonathan P. Wilmer.

By the Petition of William Clarke of George Town it appears that he was on three several Presentments fined the sum of six pounds on each by the Corporation of George Town. The Petitioner states that in the Year 1794 he rented a House in George Town and prepared himself for keeping a Tavern and endeavoured to obtain a Licence according to law for that purpose. That William Craik the Chief Justice being absent from home, Thomas Turner one of the Associate Justices having resigned and the other Associate Justice being absent from the County he did not obtain a permit until the sitting of the Court.
