Friday November the 1. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur Shaaff

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Price Esquire, the
sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings, for three quarters
Salary as a Member of the Council; due this day.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Arthur Shaaff the sum of one hundred
and eighty two pounds fifteen shillings for six Months Salary as a Member of
The Council; due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Nerian Pinkney, one hundred
and fifty pounds, for six Months Salary as Clerk of the Council; due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Archibald Van Horn, fourteen
pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the
Senate due as above.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr.
Nancy de Vacher, fifteen pounds, for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant
John Trueman, fifteen pounds, for one quarters half pay; due as above.

Saturday November the 2. 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur
Shaaff John Davidson and Jonathan P. Wimer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Thomas the
sum of fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence for one quarter
as a Member of the Council due the first instant

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to John Davidson Esquire, the
sum of fifty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence for one quarters Salary
of the Council; due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to
Esquire, the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence
quarters Salary as Clerk of the House of Representatives.
