

Friday November the 8/1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble Arthur.

John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan B. Wimer.

By the Petition of Jacob Jones of Caroline County accompanied by a Return, from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was presented at October Term 1799 and was fined on five several occasions the sum of six pounds on each for selling spiritous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that the said offences were committed whilst he was a Citizen of the State of Delaware and was at the time of selling the liquors aforesaid ignorant of the Laws of Maryland. That he is poor and has a sickly wife and two small grand children, who depend on his labour for support. The Board on consideration and from the Recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fines.
