

Tuesday December 3. 1799

The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas Buchanan
Jonathan. R. Wilmer, James Thomas and John Davidson.

John Rawlings was appointed Coroner for Cecil
County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
to John Done Esquire the sum of one hundred and
eighty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarters
Salary as Judge of the General Court due the first
day of last month.

Friday December 5th 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Gov-
ernor and all the members.

Arthur Staaff Esquire elected a member of the
Council on the eighteenth ultimo appeared and
qualified before Allen Luyzen Esquire a Justice
of the Peace for anne arundell County.

Jonathan Pinney was appointed a Judge of the
Orphan Court of anne arundell County and Commission
issued accordingly to William Harwood, James Mack-
ubin and Jonathan Pinney as Judges of the Orphan
Court of the said County.

By the Petition of John Donovan of Harford
County accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceed-
ings of the Court of the said County it appears that
he was presented in three several Presentments
for selling spiritous Liquors without Licence and
was fined six hundred pounds of Tobacco on each. The
Petitioner states that he is poor and has a large family
to support. He therefore prays a Remission of the same.
The Board on consideration of which circumstances and
from the recommendation of the Court of the said County
do order and direct that he be released from the
aforesaid sum on payment of costs of Suit.
