

Saturday February 1. 1800

The Council met. Present The Honble Arthur Haaff
James Thomas and John Davidson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore
pay to John Davidson Esquire, the sum of fifty
pounds, for one quarters salary as a member of
the Council, due this day.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western
Shore pay to Colonel Uriah Forrest, Merly three
pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters half
pay due as above.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore
pay to Mrs Ann Sebacher the sum of fifteen pounds
for one quarters half pay due as above.

Monday February 3. 1800

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore
pay to Minian Pimney the sum of seventy five
pounds, for one quarters salary as Clerk of the
Council, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore
pay to Colonel John. N. Stone the sum of forty three
pounds three shillings and nine pence for one
quarters half pay, due as above.

Wednesday February 5. 1800

The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas
Buchanan, Arthur Haaff and John Davidson

By the Petition of Thomas Mfausland of
Washington County it appears that he was
presented at December Term last for selling
liquors without licence and was fined in
each case the sum of twenty pounds amounting
in the whole to forty pounds. The petitioner
states that he applied, and obtained directions
from Alexander Flagett a Justice of the Peace
to the Clerk for a licence but not having
sufficient money about him to pay for it
the Clerk refused to let him have it. That he
proceeded to sell conceiving that he might do
so under the directions of the said Alexander
