

Resolved, that the Surveyor of said County be and he is hereby directed to survey at the expense of George Gale of the said County all that Tract or Parcel of Land being a part of Newannaught Manor lying in said County aforesaid which was purchased by a certain John Ryan of said County of Daniel of Saint Thomas Sheriff then Intendant of the Province of the State of Maryland and by the said John Ryan conveyed to the said George Gale by a Deed dated on the first day of December in the year seventeen hundred and ninety six, agreeably to the Resolution of the General Assembly passed at November Session eighteen hundred

By the Reformation of Frederick County Court it appears that Peter Grove was presented and fined for keeping an Ordinary without licence. The Court further state that the said Grove was prevented from seeking from attending Court to get his licence and that the said Grove was ignorant that the Justices had a power to grant permits during the Recess of the Court. They therefore recommend a Remission of two thirds of the said fine. The Board do on consideration of which order and direct that the said Peter Grove be released from the quantity of four thousand pounds of Tobacco it being two thirds of the said fine.
